

Rutland, ND: The memorial service for Renee Cramton will be 2:00 p.m. Saturday, November 12, 2022 at the Nordland Lutheran Church of Rutland. Rev. Julie Johnson will officiate the service. Visitation will be 6-7:00 p.m. Friday at the church with a 7:00 p.m. prayer service. Private family inurnment of Renee's cremains will take place at a later date.

Renee Sheila Cramton was born April 1, 1945, in Sioux Falls, SD to Martin and Elizabeth (Pullman) Erickson. She grew up on a farm near Bridgewater, SD and graduated from Bridgewater High School in 1963.

Renee worked at Sears for a period of time in Sioux Falls and later at Northwest Bank.



On March 8th, 1964, Renee married Arthur 'Junior' Kieper in Bridgewater. He passed away on April 14th, 1979. On June 20, 1981, Renee married Earl Cramton in Sioux Falls. They had made their home in Rutland since that time.

Renee was a member of the Nordland Lutheran Church of Rutland where she had been a member of the ELCW, Altar Guild and taught Sunday School. She was community minded as evidenced by her helping with volunteering to make lefse for the Rutland Uffda Day. She was part of a group of church ladies that would sew quilts. In her free time, Renee enjoyed being a homemaker, gardening and camping while vacationing in the Black Hills. She was an avid quilter and sewer, making many quilts and blankets. But most of all, Renee also enjoyed a cup of coffee with a friend, old or new.

Renee passed away Sunday, November 6th, 2022, at Sanford Hospice House in Fargo, ND at the age of 77.
