After paroling prison on December 13, 2008, Tony Hoffman started living out his dream, with his addiction behind him. Tony is a Former BMX Elite Pro and placed 2nd at the 2016 World Championships in Medellin Colombia in the Masters Pro class. Tony coached Women's Elite Pro, Brooke Crain, to a 4th place finish at the 2016 Rio Olympic Games in Brazil.

Tony has presented on the prestigious TEDx stage and his viral Goalcast video 'From Prison to the Olympics' has been viewed more than 12 million times. He is a founder of pH Wellness, a drug and alcohol addiction treatment facility located in Southern California which uses his 'F.I.T For Life' sobriety model utilizing fitness and a world class career placement center to increase long term recovery outcomes.

Tony is an author & one of the most requested mental health & substance use speakers in the country, traveling over 200 days a year to share his inspiring story with various audiences. Tony's life motto is, "The story we create about the experience is more important than the experience itself"

Forman, ND: The funeral for Lois Johnson will be 11:00 a.m. Wednesday, November 23, 2022, at Trinity Lutheran Church in Forman. Rev. Julie Johnson will officiate. Burial will be at the Forman Cemetery under the direction of the Price Funeral Chapel.

Lois Ida Krause was brought into the world by her grandmother on July 25, 1939, to Clinton and Susie (Neumiller) Krause in Wells County, ND joining her brother Vernon. She attended Bowdon High School and after graduation moved to Hopkins, MN where she found a job in the business office of a school. In 1959 she married Roger Johnson in Bowdon, ND and then returned to Hopkins where they continued to work. It was there that their first child, Cindy was born. They lived in various places after that, but it was in Hillsboro, ND where their second daughter, Penny was born. They



later moved to Embden, ND where son Kurt joined his two sisters and then in 1972 the family moved to Forman, where Lois remained until her passing.

Lois always had a love for music, as she grew up listening to her father play his concertina, which he self-taught. Lois learned to play the piano and would sometimes play alongside her father. Later, she learned to play the electric organ, so the cycle would continue, by Lois' children being able to grow up listening to her and their Grandpa Clinton's music. Roger passed away in 1999, but Lois was able to remain in her apartment for almost ten years, often blessed by her grandchildren popping by after school. In 2009 she entered the Four Seasons Healthcare Center, bringing her organ with her, which she continued to play until her rheumatoid arthritis prevented her from doing so.

She never lost her love of music, and she was always present when the nursing home would be treated to special music by various people coming to play for the residents. She discovered RFDTV and would religiously watch Molly B's polka show on Wednesday and Saturday nights; eating supper in her room Wednesdays so she wouldn't miss it. She was thrilled that she was able to meet Molly B when Kurt took her Hankinson Polka Fest in 2016. She even had her picture taken with her! She enjoyed listening to Molly B CD's, reading a good book and completing Hidden Word Search puzzle books at a rapid pace.

Grateful for having shared her life are her three children: Cindy Leinen, Fargo, ND; Penny (Mike) Lock, Forman, ND; and Kurt Johnson, West Fargo, ND; three grandchildren: Morgan (Travis) Peterson, Rutland, ND; Quinn Lock, Forman, ND; and Bianca Schleske, Fargo, ND; a great grandson, Nate Peterson, Rutland, ND; sister in-law, Barbara Krause-Martin, nephew, Tim Krause, Bowdon, ND and a niece, Lisa House, Carrington, ND; great-nieces, great-nephew and friends of the family. Preceding her in death were her parents, her husband, Roger, her brother, Vernon, one grandson, Brent Johnson and an infant great grandson, Harrison Peterson.

Lois passed away on Thursday, November 17^{th} at Sanford Hospital in Fargo, ND at the age of 83 with her children by her side.
