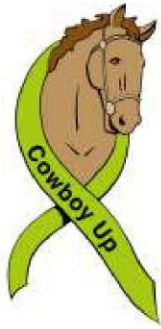

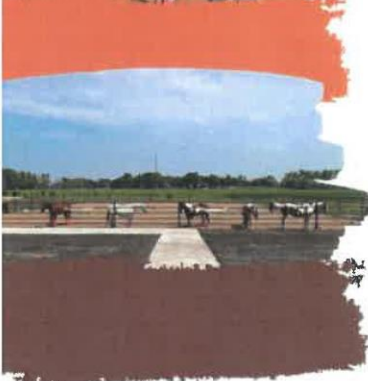

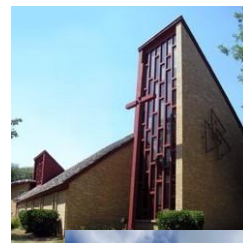

Orinne J. Sundlie was born December 21, 1937 to Clarence, SR. and Matilda (Saunders) Sundlie. She was raised in Rutland, ND and graduated from Rutland High School. After graduation she went to Ellendale for her teaching certificate. She taught at rural country school for a couple years.

In 1959 she married Larry Wanous and they had two children, Sherri and Shane. They lived in various towns throughout their marriage including the farm in Kidder, SD, Ellendale, ND, St. Paul and White Bear Lake, MN. However, they spent the most time in Osceola, WI and while there Orinne worked at the grade school as a teacher's aide. She moved back to South Dakota in 1972 and owned and operated the Clear Lake Resort for a number of years before moving just south of Havana, ND. Orinne then lived in Britton, SD and worked various jobs while there. She bartended at Hunters and the Legion VFW Post 3507 before becoming the manager of the VFW for a decade. She enjoyed her time bartending, getting to know all the customers and creating unique fun activities over the years.

After the VFW she moved her trailer house to Rutland to help care for her mother. Following her mother's passing she remained in Rutland until her health started to decline. She then went to live with her son in Brainerd, MN until the time of her passing. Orinne was a loving and giving person. She was known for opening her home to those in need of place to stay during a storm or just to visit. Her family was important to her and she cherished all the time spent with her grandchildren. She also loved to talk with the children in town and hand out little memento's to them. She was a hard worker but would look forward to the evenings when she could sit back and relax with a good book. In her spare time she also loved to do carpentry work around the house and gardening.

She passed away Saturday, July 29, 2023 at Four Seasons in Forman at the age of 85.

She is survived by her two children: Sherri (Brett Johanneson) Hilleson and Shane (Annette) Wanous; her grandchildren: Justin Hilleson, Matthew Hilleson and Audrey Wanous and her siblings: Clarence (Sharon) Sundlie, JR. and Darlene McLaen and many cousins and nephews. Preceding her in death are her parents and her sister, Jenene Sundlie. The family is planning a private inurnment at a later date.
