## COLLECTED TOO FEW WATER SAMPLES

The City of Forman is required to monitor your drinking water for specific contaminants on a regular basis. Results of regular monitoring are an indicator of whether our drinking water meets health standards. During the month of May 2025, we did not complete all microbiological monitoring or testing and therefore cannot be sure of the quality of our drinking water during that time.

A minimum of one (1) acceptable sample was to be submitted to a certified laboratory for microbiological analysis. Records show zero (0) acceptable samples were submitted for the month of May 2025.

The City of Forman regrets that this error in meeting monitoring requirements occurred. It is recognized that a complete monitoring program is of great value in making certain that safe drinking water is provided to all consumers. Steps have been taken to ensure that adequate monitoring will be performed in the future.

A sample had been done by the City of Forman, but due to postponement in USPS they did not receive it on time. A new sample has since been done and water has been tested and approved.
