





Janna was born on January 7, 1943 in Breckenridge, Minnesota. Shortly after she was born, Janna moved with her family from the farm where they lived near Milnor, North Dakota to a farm just outside of Havana, North Dakota. Janna attended school in Havana and graduated from Havana High School in 1961.

After high school, Janna attended Josef's School of Hair Design in Fargo, North Dakota and worked as a hairdresser in Fargo for a short time.
