Sargent County Museum in Forman, ND announces what will be in new building.

Now to announce what will be on exhibit in the new building. We will be bringing back in all the newspaper equipment from the county that made it through the collapse. It will be in the NW corner where the cook car was. Most of the farm equipment the museum owned and a few items that are donated from the 1910 Titan to the 1960 small tractors will be in it.

We will no longer be telling the story of steam threshing days. We will now be telling the history and story of Melroe, Keller and now Bobcat. It has a strong history in Sargent County and North Dakota, and we will have the first complete story in this building. We plan to have STEM/ hands on stations throughout the building. We also plan on having our video stories back on three TV's in the building. You will have a chance to walk around some of the farm machines with an open plan layout. You will have an opportunity to take selfies with the machines. We also have in the works QR codes to scan to see more photos and info on items in the building. Our flip books will be back but nice and sleek looking in black metal on top of our black barrier stands complemented with black poly rope connecting them.


With the concrete floor and hopefully heating and whole house dehumidifier in it, we plan to have more school classes visit us and more group tours in it later in the Fall and be able to open early in the Spring. Buildings 1 & 2 are already climate controlled and able to be used all year round and we hope to get this building there to.
