

One Man's Journey Through Music

Local music instructor and professional musician Chris Argenziano has played guitar for roughly 26 years. He first got his hands on a guitar at 14, after his brother had borrowed a guitar from their grandma and taught himself to play using Metallica tabs and simple cord books.

After some time, he found that he enjoyed playing and did what most other musicians do -- he started collecting guitars.

"I currently have 15 guitars, four of which are the main ones I play, and a lot of them sit in a closet that need to be listed or donated," Chris laughed.

Like many other musicians, Chris started playing with his buddies, which is how his first band, Head Shop, was formed. They continued to play and, as always, went through a series of name changes before they landed on Soul Patch Adams. This was roughly around the time I met Chris, and being under 21 at the time, I never had the opportunity to hear them play live, as they were exclusively playing at bars during this time. They played the Elks Lodge and the old JT Cigarras on 45th Street in Fargo.

"The focus then was actually like writing our tunes too, which was a lot of fun, and it was interesting because I started out playing a ton of metal," explained Chris. "I still love metal, but then I heard the album Dave Matthews and Tim Reynolds Live at Luther College, and I was like, holy ****!"

To this day, Tim Reynolds has inspired Chris, and he often receives feedback from listeners that his style reflects that of Tim Reynolds, which is a big compliment.

"As you predicted, the band broke up before you ever got to come and see us," joked Chris.

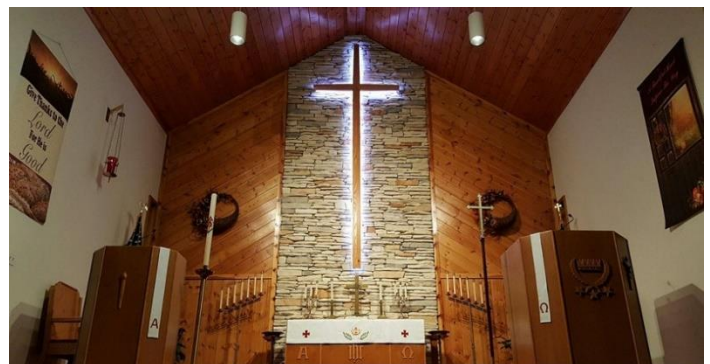
