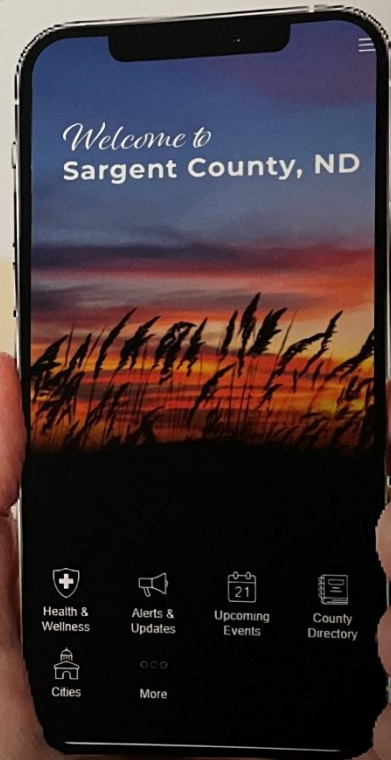

Connie Jean McLaen of Inver Grove Heights, MN, died May 11, 2022, at Regions Hospital, St. Paul, MN. She was born July 25, 1939, in Britton, SD, to Roy and Clara (“Tillie” Jensen) McLaen.

In 1941, they moved from the farm near Rutland to St. Paul where they bought a home on Sherburne Avenue. This 3-story home allowed them to host “boarders” who rented rooms. When Connie was a senior in high school, they took in two young boarders, Elaine (Nelson) Anderson and Ardie (Brezicka) Crandall, who were treated as family. Connie remembered that there were always people around sharing stories and laughter, making it a fun place to grow up!



In 1970 Connie ventured to Hawaii to visit a friend and ended up staying there and working for 10 years at the Kaiser Foundation Hospital. She moved back to St. Paul in 1980 and worked for the St. Paul Police Department for 21 years. Connie became a loving caregiver to her mother and in 2007 they returned to ND, living in Forman until Tillie’s passing. The following year, Connie moved back to their townhome in Inver Grove Heights where she lived until her recent death due to natural causes related to cardiac failure. While Connie never married nor had siblings, she lived her life amid dear friends regardless of where she was.

She is preceded in death by her parents and is survived by friends, cousins, and co-workers. Friends and family are welcome to honor Connie during a brief memorial celebration of her life on Sunday, July 24, 2022, 1:00PM at the Rutland Cemetery where she will be laid to rest next to her parents.

Eventually, Pat was unable to maintain employment.

Pat enjoyed comedic movies, country music, her cat Rocky, and last but not least, spending time with her family.

Left to mourn Pat's passing are one sister, Linda (John) Quimby; one nephew, Gabriel Quimby, three "step-nieces" Leslie Quimby, Tracy Quimby, and Christina (Andrew) Johnston and numerous aunts, uncles, and cousins.

Preceding her in death were her parents, grandparents and an infant sister.
