





Are you ready to respond to an active bleed injury on your farm or in your community? Learn how you can make a difference by attending Stop the Bleed!

Stop the Bleed is a nationally recognized, 90-minute certification program that teaches participants to recognize life-threatening bleeding from injuries and how to intervene effectively by properly using a tourniquet in the event of blood loss caused by an injury.

- Farm and ranch families
- Farm employees and seasonal laborers
- Emergency response personnel (NCCR credits available)
