

Interesting facts:

The average business survives 2 years.

The average bank is only 38 years old.

Stock Growers Bank is 125 years old.

The United States of America is 249 years old.

In the fall of 1936, the Bank of Sargent County was closed by examiners and an offer was made to the Directors of the Havana State Bank to move their charter to Forman which was the County Seat.

After a series of meetings, the Directors voted to move the charter. The bank would be called Sargent County Bank, and it officially opened on January 15th, 1937. The Roosevelt Administration declared a "Bank Holiday nationwide in the early 1930s and closed all the Banks in the country for a short period of time to prevent a huge run on all of the banks. Havana State was the only bank in Sargent County that didn't fail.

The Havana Bank was robbed twice in 1933 on April 17th and again on June 20th.

Two of the three robbers were in both hold ups as they later were caught due to other robberies they had committed in South Dakota. G. A. Klefstad and Helen Kriesel were the two employees locked in the vault at the first hold up. A screwdriver and pliers in the vault were used to take the lock apart and they escaped. Around \$7,800 in cash and bonds were taken the first time.

In the second hold up around \$800 was taken and after having read accounts of the employee's previous escape, the leader of the robberies removed any tools from the vault preventing any escape the second time, thus giving himself away as having been involved before. Miss Kriesel was taken hostage from the bank and held on the running board of the V8 Ford until they were out of town where she was released. The robbers pistol whipped Mr. Klefstad and left him in the vault. The robbers were later captured and both Kriesel and Klefstad went to St. Cloud, Mn to identify the three men. An interesting conversation was had between G. A. Klefstad and the leader who apologized for hitting Gilman during the second robbery. Those were hard times in America, but even the robbers had a conscious.

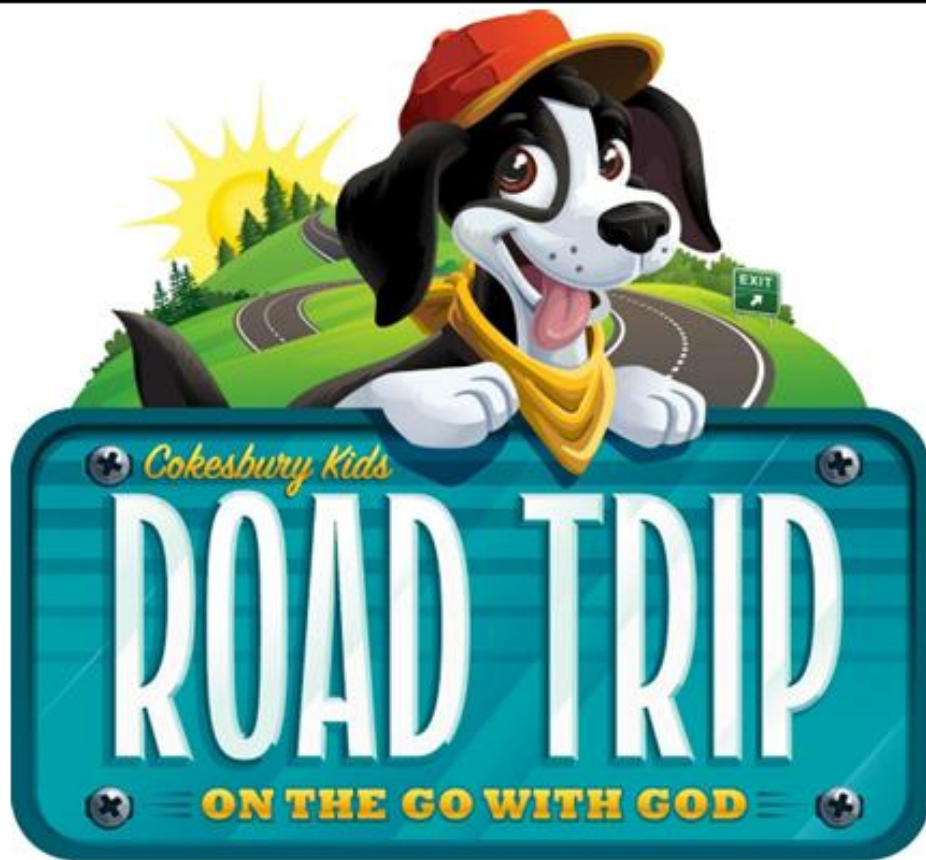

Who was Randall Edison?

Randall Edison was born in 1950, in Fargo to David and Karen (Schutt) Edison. He grew up in Milnor and graduated from Milnor High School. In 1971, he enlisted in the U.S. Army and served in Vietnam. While serving in Vietnam, he was awarded the Distinguished Flying Cross for heroism. When he returned to Milnor, Randy worked at Edison Motors, the family Ford dealership. He began working at Bobcat in Gwinner in 1987. A loyal union man, Randy was a member of PACE and later, United Steel Workers Local 560. He was also a state and local union officer, serving as Financial Secretary Treasurer of USW Local 560 and Vice President and Alternate for the North Dakota AFL-CIO Executive Council. After retiring from Bobcat in 2007, Randy was instrumental in forming the first SOAR (Steelworkers Organization of Active Retirees) Chapter in North Dakota and served as its President.



Randy was a member of Smith-Thune American Legion Post 148 and was also a life member of Gibbon Miller VFW Post 9069, where he served as Post Commander.

He also served as District Commander of the VFW, a member of the Vietnam Veterans of America, and President of the Milnor City Council. Randy was an avid Minnesota Vikings fan and enjoyed watching the Minnesota Twins. He enjoyed spending time with family and watching his grandchildren participate in sports.

Randall Edison passed away at the age of 63 after a courageous battle with cancer.

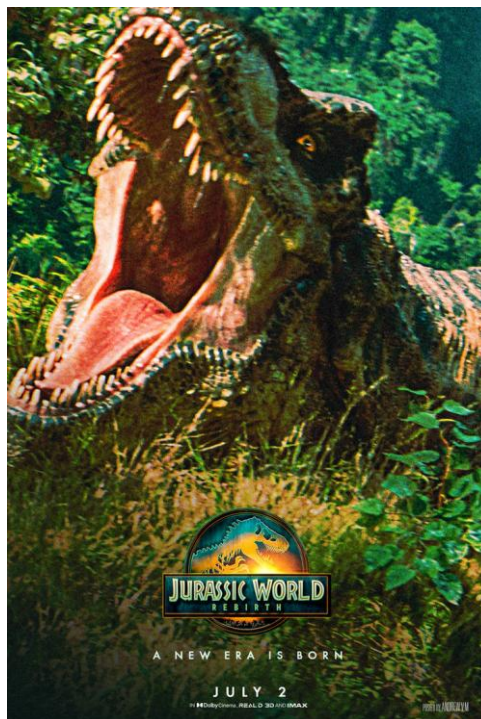

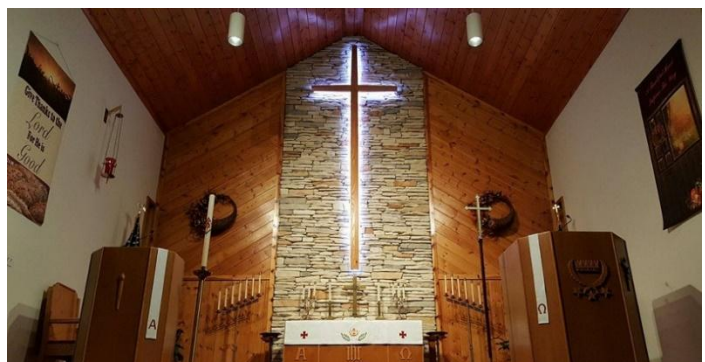
