Tractor Safety Camp is designed to teach youth how to be safe on the farm. The camp is for youth ages 13-15 who plan to work on a farm and is required by the Hazardous Occupations Order in Agriculture (HOOA) for youth to work for someone other than their immediate family. Youth will learn safe practices around farm equipment, rules of the road, ATV safety, livestock handling, dangers of grain bins, first aid techniques and labor laws. Upon completion of the camp, youth will acquire a farm permit to operate farm equipment and work around livestock for hire. The camp is filled with fun activities and hands-on tractor driving. 4-H membership is not required for participation.

Forman, ND: The Mass of Christian Burial for Vivian Kosmatka will be 10:30 a.m. Friday, May 6, 2022 at St. Mary's Catholic Church in Forman. Rev. Fr. Timothy Schroeder and Rev. Fr. Tom Feltman will concelebrate. Interment will be in the St. Mary's Cemetery of Forman. Visitation will be 7-9:00 p.m. Thursday, May 5 at the church concluding with a vigil service.

Vivian Linstad was born July 23, 1922 in rural Pennington County, Minnesota to Ole and Clara (Bang) Linstad.

Vivian traveled to California to be a nanny during World War II, where she met and married her first husband William Snider, who died before the birth of their first child. She then married David Kosmatka, and they happily raised seven children together. David and Vivian moved to Forman in 1957, and Vivian lived there for the next 60 years.

Vivian was an enthusiastic and tireless worker. She was very active at St Mary's Catholic Church, teaching CCD, working the food stand at the county fair, reader, communion assistant, and fed many a priest and sister. She was also active in the American Legion Auxiliary, ran the food pantry, worked at the Price Funeral Chapel, sold Tupperware, helped serve meals at Seniors, was an election worker, quilted, and was a fabulous cook and baker (buns, orange rolls, cinnamon and caramel rolls - yum).

Vivian nurtured many a young mother, and many kids in Forman lovingly called her Gramma. She also helped raise a granddaughter, Kristen, after the death of her mother. Vivian enjoyed a trip of a lifetime to Poland with a church group, and also traveled to Hawaii.

She passed away Thursday, April 28, 2022 at Four Seasons Healthcare Center in Forman, three months short of her 100th birthday.

Vivian is survived by her sons Kent (Jean) and Kyle (Kristi); grandchildren: William Snider, Tracy Snider, Kristen Kosmatka, Jennifer Kiebach, David Kosmatka, Zachary Kosmatka, Jerry Kosmatka, Sean Kosmatka, Cassandra Kosmatka, and Cheyenne Kosmatka; and many great and great-great grandchildren.

She is preceded in death by her parents and siblings, husbands, William Snider and David Kosmatka, sons, Bill Snider, David Jr. Kosmatka and Kurt Kosmatka, daughters, Fran Cortez and Debi Kosmatka.
