

The Lariat Bar:

OPPORTUNITY FOR SMALL TOWN LIVING AND BUSINESS SUCCESS

A handful of people from Rutland, N.D., and the surrounding area have formed a grass-roots team to get behind reopening the local bar and restaurant, The Lariat. The business closed last year due to health problems by the former owner.

At a community meeting in August, more than 30 people showed up to discuss what it would take to reopen the doors of the business. The turnout far exceeded what was expected in a town of 160 people. A straw poll showed that far more than the \$150,000 needed would be available to purchase the building from the bank through potential investors in the room.

With this strong demonstration of support, a short-term project-focused team of three individuals agreed to lay forth a project plan and pursue immediate steps toward their goal. The team includes Katie McLaen, Paul Anderson, and Michael Wyum.

The group has begun a collective community-ownership enterprise in North Dakota and is in the process of purchasing the property. The group will identify key decisions to be made, including legal structure and share ownership options.

Many expressing interest in the project have stated to the project team that they are motivated in restoring an important community asset and social hub – largely regarding their stock in the project as a "contribution."

The Lariat has been a fixture on Rutland's main street for generations. It has been a popular place for farmers and families to eat out, socialize, celebrate, and meet for many decades. In addition, it was a destination for those from nearby towns to enjoy a steak, walleye or burger with just a short drive.

An early priority will be finding an individual or family to operate the restaurant. Making it attractive for any restaurateur will be a debt-free building owned by local people ready to support the business with their patronage. Once established, it may be possible for the operator to buy the building at some point they've demonstrated their ability to sustain the enterprise.

The Lariat building is only 13 years old and the kitchen is in excellent condition. The bar, pool tables, equipment and fixtures have all been well maintained and it's essentially a turnkey business opportunity.
