





#### John Totenhagen

John Totenhagen, 95, of rural Stirum passed away on February 13, 2023 surrounded by family at CHI in Oakes, North Dakota.

John Christ Totenhagen was born to John F. and Alma (Mathias) Totenhagen on December 16, 1927 at the family farm rural Stirum. John attended country school and graduated from Stirum High School. He began farming with his father raising livestock and grains. On June 17, 1951 he married Janice Wedel at St. John's Lutheran Church in Oakes. Together, they were blessed with five children.



John thoroughly enjoyed farming and was proud to see the family farm continue into the fourth generation. John actively farmed and hauled all the harvest from field to farm up to age 89.

John was an active member of Immanuel Lutheran Church, rural Stirum and served in several offices. He also served on the Ransom/Sargent County Farmers Mutual Insurance as a director, ASCS Board, Gwinner Farmers Elevator Board of Directors and Sargent County Water Board. In November of 2022, John and Janice moved into the Villas Assisted Living in Forman.

John is survived by his wife Janny of 71 years, children Melinda (Paul) Skorheim, Alexandria, MN; Mary (Dennis) Miller, Lake Park, MN; Kay (Mark) Osman, Fargo, ND; David (LaurieAnn) Totenhagen, Stirum, ND; 15 grandchildren, 24 great-grandchildren and one sister, Esther Orn, Fargo, ND.

John is preceded in death by his parents, 3 half-brothers, 2 half-sisters and his oldest son William Lee Totenhagen.

His funeral service will be held on Saturday, February 18, 2023 at 10:30 a.m. at St. John's Lutheran Church in Oakes with visitation one hour prior. Burial will take place at Stirum Cemetery near Stirum at a later date.
