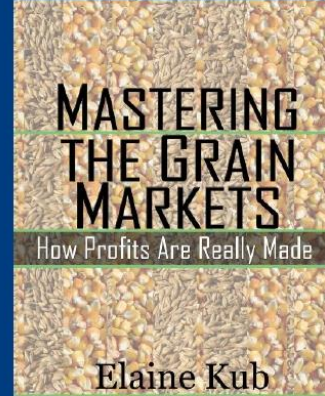

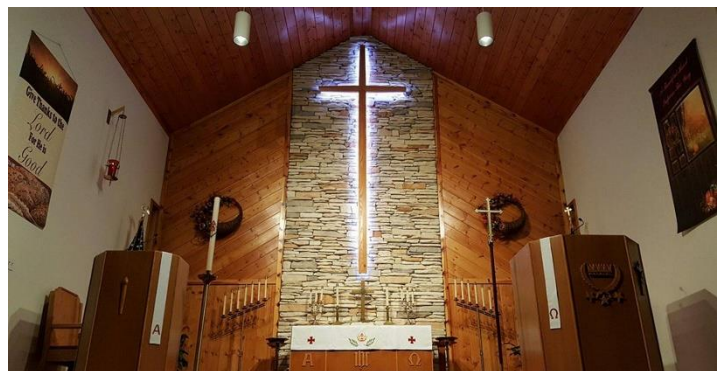

Spring burial will be in the Forman Cemetery under the direction of the Price Funeral Chapel. There will be a one hour visitation prior to the service at the church.

Irene May Ellsworth was born to Thomas and Augusta (Rein) Oland at home in rural Weber township, Havana, ND on August 26, 1927.

Irene began her education attending country school in rural Havana. As the family moved to Forman, she attended school there and graduated from Forman High School in 1945.



After graduation she began working at the Forman Post Office. It was while working there that she met the love of her life, Louis Ellsworth. They were married November 10, 1956 at the United Methodist Church in Oakes, ND.
