Another Way to Help the Sargent County Museum Rebuild



Grain for Goodness

Grain for Goodness is a program that Full Circle Ag has to help support their local communities. The Sargent County Museum in Forman, ND has applied for the program and is conditionally approved. They had a building that received too much snow on it with the last snowstorm in April and on April 6, 2023 their building number 3 which housed the story of farm equipment collapsed under the weight of the snow. They were under insured and insurance will only cover 48% of the cost to rebuild the building as it stood. They would like to rebuild next summer and need to raise the funds to do this. As a member owned cooperative Full Circle Ag has the ability to help out in these types of situations. Just as member - owners' partner with them for their crop inputs, they also believe in returning the loyalty by partnering to support their local communities. If you do business with Full Circle Ag ask them how you can help the Sargent County Museum. Full Circle Ag will match your contribution plus they will contact Land O Lakes for a match also which means your contribution as a farmer will be tripled! So, you give \$250 and the Museum will get \$750. Contact Kelli Erickson at 605-824-6949 to sign up and for more details. Just one more way you can help the Sargent County Museum rebuild!

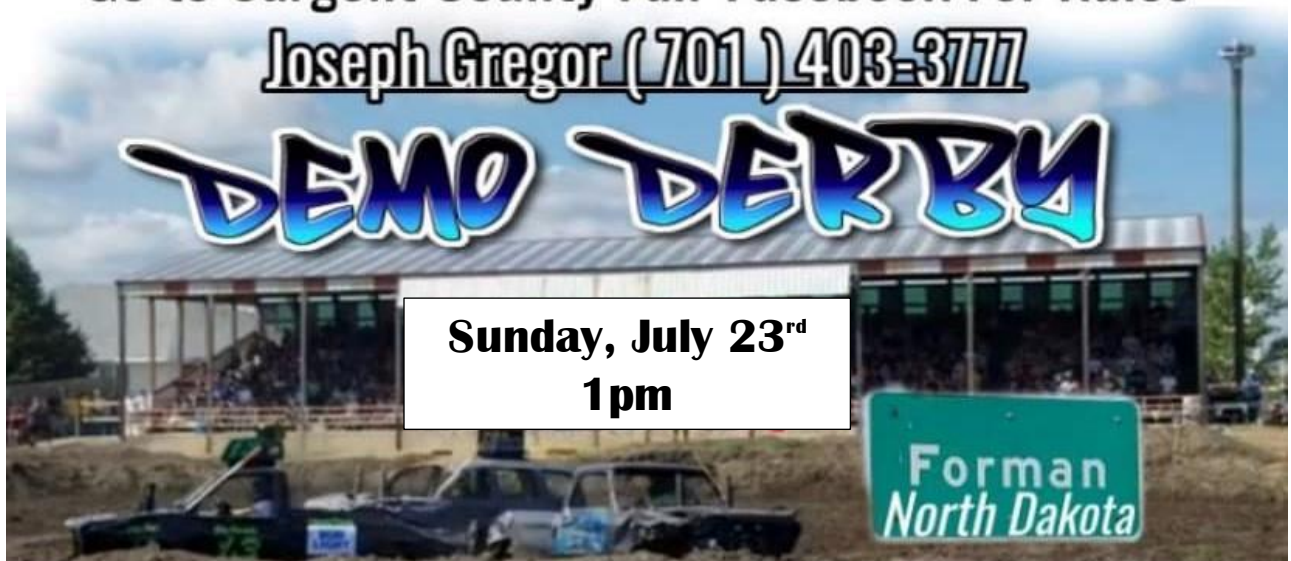

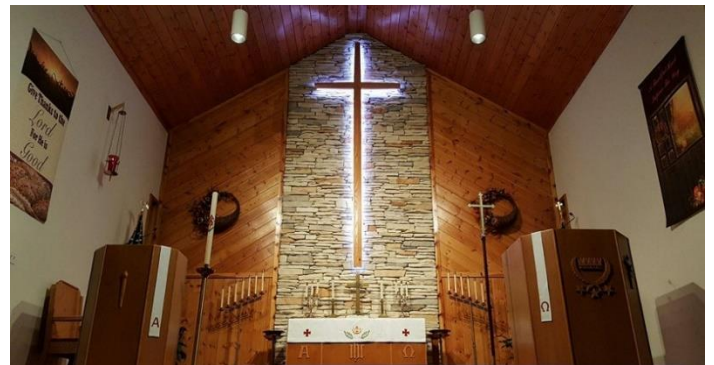
