Sargent County Museum needs your help!

#### **Grain for Goodness**

Attention all area growers! Grain for Goodness is a program developed by Full Circle Ag to partner up and make your dollars go further when supporting our local communities. The Sargent County Museum has applied and is conditionally approved for the program. The museum's building #3 received too much snow on the roof during the last snow storm of April 2023 and on April 6th it collapsed under the weight. This building housed the story of farm equipment. They were under insured; insurance will only cover 48% of the cost to rebuild the building as it stood. They would like to rebuild next summer and need to raise the funds to do this. As a member owned cooperative Full Circle Ag has the ability to help out in these types of situations. Just as member owners' partner with them for their crop inputs, Full Circle Ag believes in returning the loyalty by partnering to support our local communities. As a Grower doing business with Full Circle Ag ask how you can donate up to \$500 worth of grain bushels to be donated to the Sargent County Museum through Grain for Goodness. Full Circle Ag will match your check, plus they will submit the donation to be matched by Land O'Lakes as well, which means your donation as a farmer will be tripled! So, if you give \$500 the museum receives, in total \$1,500! Please call Kali, 701-997-2970, at Full Circle Ag for more details, she will be able to work with you to make your donation possible.

This is just one more way you can help the Sargent County Museum rebuild!

The Museum is open Monday – Friday 10am – 4pm, in the first two buildings facing the parking lot. And open Sundays when a volunteer is available 1-4pm. Before a final resolution can be passed, public hearings are required. The commission would like to receive the public's input on whether or not they should proceed.






