June Marie Tate was born January 26, 1951 in Fargo, ND to George Thomas and Mary Susan (Murch) Tate and raised in Erie, ND. She attended school in Erie and graduated from Arthur High School in Arthur, ND. She then attended Mayville State College for four years earning a teaching degree.



Following college, she taught school in Edmore, ND for a couple of years before moving to Forman for a teaching position. There she met Gerald Fritzen and they were married on June 11, 1977. They made their home in Forman. After retiring from teaching, she began volunteering at the Sargent County Museum as the curator.
