OFFICIAL KRAFT SLOUGH FISHING TOURNAMENT RULES 2024 ALL CURRENT ND GAME & FISH REGULATIONS MUST BE FOLLOWED AND ND STATE LAWS OBEYED.

A current ND Fishing license is required.

Registration will be at the Benzel's Bay lake access point at the northeast corner of the property.

One ticket allows you to weigh and enter one fish. Additional tickets must be purchased to weigh additional fish. All tickets must be purchased in advance to enter and weigh fish. Additional tickets will be available for sale at the registration office during registration hours.

\$10.00 ticket per contestant per fish, of which \$1.00 is for fishing entry and \$9.00 for prizes.

All contestants are required to register during the registration period from 6:00 AM to 9:00 AM.

Tourrament fishing will take place from 6:00 AM until 12:00 PM local time. Fish must be weighed no later than 12:30 PM.

All tourpeast fishing must be advantaged for the contest of the property of the contest o

man 12-30 FM. All tournament fishing must be done in designated area, Kraft Slough/Lake ND west of 119th Ave SE, North of 89th St SE, ND. Contestants south or east of these boundaries will be disqualified. All fish to be submitted for weight are encouraged to do so immediately after being caught. Only live, fresh, and unfrozen fish are eligible. Only fish caught during contest hours, within tournament boundaries,

d by tournament rules are eligible.
Fish caught and weighed are the contestants to keep.
In the event of a tie weight, the first fish weighed will be awarded higher prize.
Entrant may move locations at will at any time within the tournament boundaries.

Any fish taken from the lake must be transported in a dry container and must abide by all state laws. Entrant must provide it's own shelter and drill and maintain own holes. Line and hole must be maintained and monitored or must be removed from water.

Contestants cannot share fish.

Small bast buckets are allowed. Entrant must supply their own bait, must comply with NDGFD regulations.

NO coolers or other large containers will be allowed. All personal articles are subject to search for illegal

Small oan Ouscas as a constrainers will be allowed. All personal articles are subject to scarcn for megafish.

All electronic fishing devices (sonar, underwater cameras, etc.) are allowed during tournament hours.

NO alcohol, tobacco, or drug use is allowed in the tournament area. Signs of intoxication will be reason
for disqualification of entrain and associated parties without refund.

Failure to comply by these rules may lead to disqualification without refund. All judges decisions are final.
Site of the tournament will be Kraft Slough/Lake.

Only one fishing prize per ticket, Contestants are allowed multiple tickets.

There will be no refunds if the tournament is cancelled. IN CASE OF BAD WEATHER TOURNAMENT
WILL BE HELD ON SUNDAY, FEBRUARY 11TH under the same schedule.

Always be wary of ice conditions. Cogswell Volunteer Rural Fire District or Cogswell Gun Club or any
tournament officials will not be liable or accountable for injury, loss of life or personal property.

Prizes will be awarded according to weight determined by judges' scale and judges' final decisions. A
minimum of 75% of the tournament entry fee will be paid back to the contestants.








When our chairman, Kirk Hanson, died 1-26-2022, we could find no one able to step up and chair another reunion as Kirk was



planning to do...a final one. Some of us involved with the last reunion contacted various members, but could get no commitments due to various things happening in their lives. Our last graduating class are also in their 80's, and many live away from Forman causing travel problems. We who were involved with the last two reunions were very aware of the months of planning, and physical work involved.

On September 27, 2023, after contacting legal advice on what was required, we called a meeting at Hole-in-One with Fred (Fritz) Fiala, Vice- Chairman, conducting the meeting. Beverly Bommersbach Walstead had earlier resigned as secretary so Bonita Meester Baltes took minutes. Others attending were Cyril Kudelka, Margie Westra Roney, Jim Westra, and Elaine Nelson Anderson.....Classes of 1948, 1956, 1958, 1959, and non-grads. After much discussion, a unanimous vote was regretfully cast to disband the Forman Alumni Association due to above reasons, and to disperse the funds totaling \$2510.22.

Motion to award two \$500 scholarships to Sargent Central students graduating in 2024. Elaine was asked to meet with school staff to discuss the application process, and present the \$1000 check to the school.

A motion to give the remaining \$1510.22 to the Sargent County Museum as they had opened their doors to our reunions over the years for tours, coffee, and place to reminisce, and they were in need of funds due to the snowstorm damage to Building #3. Cyril was to present this donation to the Museum staff.

Cyril said, "All good things come to an end." and made the motion to adjourn.

The group continued to talk for hours of the various reunions, and the fun times of seeing former classmates, and hoped that any alumni coming to Forman in future years would reach out to us who continue to live at FORMAN...a Forever Hometown! We would enjoy getting together at your convenience while you are here. Thanks to all who participated in the years of reunions.
