OFFICIAL KRAFT SLOUGH FISHING TOURNAMENT RULES 2024 ALL CURRENT ND GAME & FISH REGULATIONS MUST BE FOLLOWED AND ND STATE LAWS OBEYED.

A current ND Fishing license is required.

Registration will be at the Benzel's Bay lake access point at the northeast corner of the property.

One ticket allows you to weigh and enter one fish. Additional tickets must be purchased to weigh additional fish. All tickets must be purchased in advance to enter and weigh fish. Additional tickets will be available for sale at the registration office during registration hours.

\$10.00 ticket per contestant per fish, of which \$1.00 is for fishing entry and \$9.00 for prizes.

All contestants are required to register during the registration period from 6:00 AM to 9:00 AM.

Tourrament fishing will take place from 6:00 AM until 12:00 PM local time. Fish must be weighed no later than 12:30 PM.

All tourpeast fishing must be advantaged for the contest of the property of the contest o

man 12-30 FM. All tournament fishing must be done in designated area, Kraft Slough/Lake ND west of 119th Ave SE, North of 89th St SE, ND. Contestants south or east of these boundaries will be disqualified. All fish to be submitted for weight are encouraged to do so immediately after being caught. Only live, fresh, and unfrozen fish are eligible. Only fish caught during contest hours, within tournament boundaries,

d by tournament rules are eligible.
Fish caught and weighed are the contestants to keep.
In the event of a tie weight, the first fish weighed will be awarded higher prize.
Entrant may move locations at will at any time within the tournament boundaries.

Any fish taken from the lake must be transported in a dry container and must abide by all state laws. Entrant must provide it's own shelter and drill and maintain own holes. Line and hole must be maintained and monitored or must be removed from water.

Contestants cannot share fish.

Small bast buckets are allowed. Entrant must supply their own bait, must comply with NDGFD regulations.

NO coolers or other large containers will be allowed. All personal articles are subject to search for illegal

Small oan Ouscas as a constrainers will be allowed. All personal articles are subject to scarcn for megafish.

All electronic fishing devices (sonar, underwater cameras, etc.) are allowed during tournament hours.

NO alcohol, tobacco, or drug use is allowed in the tournament area. Signs of intoxication will be reason
for disqualification of entrat and associated parties without refund.

Failure to comply by these rules may lead to disqualification without refund. All judges decisions are final.
Site of the tournament will be Kraft Slough/Lake.

Only one fishing prize per ticket, Contestants are allowed multiple tickets.

There will be no refunds if the tournament is cancelled. IN CASE OF BAD WEATHER TOURNAMENT
WILL BE HELD ON SUNDAY, FEBRUARY 11TH under the same schedule.

Always be wary of ice conditions. Cogswell Volunteer Rural Fire District or Cogswell Gun Club or any
tournament officials will not be liable or accountable for injury, loss of life or personal property.

Prizes will be awarded according to weight determined by judges' scale and judges' final decisions. A
minimum of 75% of the tournament entry fee will be paid back to the contestants.








If your pesticide applicator certification expires on April 1, 2024, you are required to attend a training or take a 60 question open book exam to renew your certification.





Havana, ND: The funeral service for Beverly "Bev" Brummond will be 10:30 a.m. Saturday, February 17, 2024 at First Lutheran Church in Britton. Rev. Terrill Sorensen will officiate the service. Interment will be at the Havana Cemetery.

Visitation will be one hour prior to the service at the church.

Beverly Jane Turner was born to Hamlin O. and Norma E. (Olson) Turner on August 4, 1932 in Faulkton, SD where she grew up and graduated from high school. At an early age she gave herself the nickname "BJ." (Her father was H.O. Turner so why shouldn't she be B.J. Turner?)



She attended South Dakota State College in Brookings, SD graduating with a B.S. degree in Home Economics Education in 1954. She taught 2 years in Tripp, SD, 1 year in Britton, SD and 1 year in Middle River, MN.

During high school she worked summers at the Faulkton Café. During her college years she worked 2 summers as a ward attendant at the South Dakota Mental Hospital in Yankton, SD and 2 summers as an assistant cook for the Minneapolis YWCA summer camp in Excelsior, MN. In 1956 she and 4 friends drove to Montreal, Canada where they boarded a ship and sailed to Europe for 5 weeks of touring.

On July 10, 1957, in Faulkton, SD she was united in marriage to John J. "Jack" Brummond of Havana, ND. They moved to Middle River, MN where they lived 4 years. They moved back to Havana, ND in 1961 to take over the Brummond family farm.

Bev was a lifetime member of the American Legion since 1939. She was a member of the Congregational Church and the VFW Auxiliary. She was an active member of the community. Some of her loves were teaching Sunday school, Homemakers Club, playing cards – especially Bridge, and gathering with friends at the Farmer's Inn Café for coffee.

Beverly "Bev" passed away Tuesday, January 31, 2024 at Wheatcrest Hills at the age of 91.

Bev is survived by her three children: Dr. Kimberley (Shelley Quandt) Brummond, Bradley (Susan) Brummond and Boyd (Teresa) Brummond; her 6 grandchildren: Jordan (Katie Carpenter) Brummond, Andrew (Danica) Brummond, Gretchen (Matthew Fraser) Brummond, Turner Brummond, Hannah (Jacob) Brooke, and JonCarl Brummond.

She was preceded in death by her parents and husband of 62 years, Jack.
